

	Revivel is a community group, set up in 2019 when the upper 3kms of the lvel, which starts in Baldock, dried up. The aim of the group is to fight the cause of the river, with the long term aim of getting brown trout swimming up the river.	
	The reasons for the current situation and what actions the group are undertaking, including their engagement with Affinity Water, the Environment Agency and local landowners, were explained.

23/039	Report from the District and County Councillor	
	A505 Speed Restriction - The online petition (https://SignMe.org.uk/2024) went to the County Councils Highways panel on 13 th September.	
	More data is to be gathered for the specific stretch of road by Slip End, not the whole stretch between Baldock and Royston.	
	 Drainage Work to The Street, Wallington - Recent correspondence has been received from Herts County Council (Richard Knight) regarding proposed works. The proposed works are potential replacement, rather than repairs, of 195m of pipework from the top of The Street by the Village Pond to the junction with Kits Lane by the Village Hall. There are no dates for when this work is to be carried out at present. 	
	 A507 Weight Restrictions - There were some objections to the formal consultation, including the District Council and Sandon residents. The objections will need to be addressed. 	
	• Solar Panel Scheme - District Council are running the bulk purchase solar panel scheme again, which is available for the parish's residents. There is a link on the Parish Council website for details of the scheme.	
23/040	Footpath FP022 – Wallington Update from Graham Lamb	-
	 The Parish Council submitted their formal response on 3rd August 2023 to HCC's consultation letter dated 29th June 2023. The Parish Council's submission confirmed that a resolution to this issue would be desirable for all parties concerned. 	
	• The Parish Council submitted their preference for the route coloured in Green on the plan dated 29 th June 2023. The exact submission in the letter was as follows:	
	'In summary if FP22 is to be changed the Parish Council supports the proposal that FP22 continues along its existing official route (shown in purple) on the map associated with the HCC letter and hence down the section of the track/driveway to the west of 7 Kits Lane (shown in green) to the car parking area on Kits Lane'	
	GL expressed his frustration at how the matter of the potential re-routing of the footpath and maintenance of the current footpath is being managed by Herts County Council and North Herts District Council.	
	• GL re-iterated the Parish Council's preference for rerouting the historic footpath (to avoid crossing the front gardens of numbers 1-7 Kits Lane and avoid damage to the habitat of the Spinney) by rerouting the footpath along the existing official route and then down the section of the track/driveway to the west of 7 Kits Lane to the car parking area on Kits Lane.	





	MSGH and a number of residents met with Countryside Management Services (Sarah Roberts) at the end of May and received a report from them in July.	
	 MSGH to meet with the Well Pond Nature Reserve Committee to run through the report and produce a grant proposal. 	MSGH
23/043	Wallington Neighbourhood Plan Update	
	The Regulation 16 Consultation has now been completed. All the responses to the consultation are published on the North Herts website.	
	The responses and objections by will be reviewed with the consultant engaged to help produce the Plan.	KH/GL
	 There were two objections to the plan during the Reg 16 consultation: 1) That residents from one household felt they had not been consulted adequately. 	
	That the local planning authority felt local housing needs had not been adequately met.	
	The Wallington councillors stated that they believe there is sufficient evidence to overcome both these objections. North Herts District Council are now looking to engage an examiner.	
	 After the examination, the final stage will be the Referendum. 	
	New funding has also been secured.

23/045	Defibrillator Update	
	 Due to a recent incident in Rushden where the defibrillator was deemed out of service by the Emergency Services, the clerks investigated why this had happened. 	
	 We discovered that sadly our contact from the East of England Ambulance Service (EEAS), Rod Taylor, passed away earlier this year. We had not been made aware of this and as a result the usual ongoing checks had not been carried out on the defibrillators. Unfortunately, we also found out that his position will not be filled. 	
	This means a new process for managing the defibrillators will be required. This will be circulated by the Clerks to the Parish Council in due course.	MSGH
	 However, as a result of recent checks, both the Rushden and Wallington defibrillators have been sent away and have had software updates as well as having new pads supplied.

	 The Defibrillators are registered with the national network managed by the Brirtish Heart Foundation (BHF). On a monthly basis the Clerks will confirm that the defibrillators are operational on the BHF website (called 'The Circuit' https://www.thecircuit.uk/) Rushden residents have requested another training session.
